PARENTAL STATEMENT OF COMMITMENT

At Baptism parents make a solemn commitment to raise their children "in the practice of the Faith". **Families need to actively participate in the life of the Church, especially in the Sunday Mass.**

Parents support the religious education curriculum by participating in parent sessions and working with their children at home. Parents ensure that their children will:

- Attend classes EACH week (5+ absences may require your child to repeat the year);
- Attend weekly Mass
- Come to class prepared;
- Have done assigned work and studied their catechism and prayers in the home;
- Participate cooperatively and respectfully with PREP staff and other children;
- Complete all the requirements of Sacrament preparation

Parents are expected to cooperate with their pastor and catechists to promote the best possible faith experience for their children.
