Parents of PREP Students:

Your son or daughter will soon be attending classes in our weekly Parish Religious Education Programme for the school year of 2020/2021.

Because of the covid -19 all students will study at home.

Please complete the registration package online and if you are not able to do so you may pick-up a registration package at the parish office. **If you have a child is entering grade 1 or are new to the programme, you will need to bring a copy of your child's baptismal certificate to the first class.** All families should be registered at St. Stephen's and have sunday envelopes. If this is not the case please complete a parish registration form. They are available at the back of the church or the parish office. You may place the completed parish registration form and return it to the parish office. If your child has not been baptized please call the prep office at 604 985-9612 to make an appointment with Fr Mark.

Parents are advised that before a child can be admitted to the confirmation class he/she must complete a full year of Grade 6 before registering for Grade 7. This means that if a child was in the programme previously and did not complete the year, they must re-register for Grade 6 and attend that year completely. The next year they may register for Grade 7. This also applies to the First Holy Communion class. The child must complete a full year of Grade 1 before registering for Grade 2. There will be exceptions for older children at the discretion of the coordinator and pastor. If this is the circumstance please call the PREP office at 604 985-9612. We thank you for your continued support.

There will be an email go out for the pick-up of your child's workbook and material. The catechists will be in touch by email and there could be some on-line instruction at a later date. I thank you for your continued support and prayers during this difficult time.
