**STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION - January 9, 2022 – The Baptism of Our Lord**

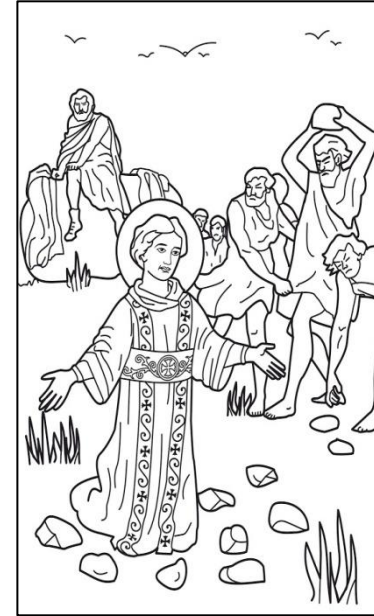

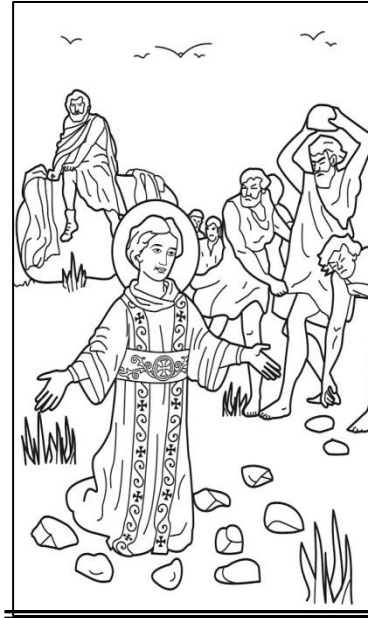
